JENNIFER J MCKINNEY, upon information and belief, affirms under penalty of perjury that:

On or about June 7, 2021 in St. Joseph County, State of Indiana, SANDER WADE RAY did knowingly take property from Tristin Rupert or the presence of Tristin Rupert, by putting Tristin Rupert in fear and while SANDER WADE RAY was armed with deadly weapon.

All of which is contrary to the form of the statutes in such cases made and provided by I.C. 35-42-5-1(a)(2), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.

COUNT II

JENNIFER J MCKINNEY, upon information and belief, affirms under penalty of perjury that:

On or about June 7, 2021 in St. Joseph County, State of Indiana, SANDER WADE RAY did knowingly take property from Jackie Murillo or the presence of Jackie Murillo, by putting Jackie Murillo in fear and while SANDER WADE RAY was armed with a deadly weapon.

All of which is contrary to the form of the statutes in such cases made and provided by I.C. 35-42-5-1(a)(2) and I.C. 35-41-2-4, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.

I affirm under the penalties for perjury that the foregoing representations are true.

the back hallway while the males finished loading iPhones into bags. They were told to turn around and count to 30.

I was provided with video and still photos of the suspects in this incident. I showed the photo of the skinner male to other officers, and Detective Matthew Napolitan immediately recognized the suspect in the Metro PCS robbery to be SANDER RAY based on prior dealings.

On June 8, 2021 other officers and I spoke with a witness, Witness 1, about a hit and run regarding her vehicle, and an auto theft report she had filed. During the interview, she indicated that she knew SANDER RAY, and that he had borrowed her car. Witness 1 indicated that she did not know anything about robberies.

After the interview, Witness 1 returned to her home. Officers watched her residence, and SANDER RAY was observed there. Officers attempted to stop him, and were unable. I spoke with Witness 1 again, and she indicated that SANDER RAY and another individual had come to her house yesterday with a bunch of new phones. Witness 1 was transported to SBPD for an interview, and she was advised of her rights under *Miranda*. Witness 1 eventually admitted that RAY and another individual were at her house the day before with firearms talking about a robbery. RAY and the other male then left the residence armed with firearms. Witness 1 indicated that RAY and the other male later came back and had a bunch of new iPhones, still in white boxes. The males then divide the cell phones between the two of them. RAY stayed in the home, and the other male left.

All incidents listed herein happened in St. Joseph County, Indiana.

I affirm, under the penalties for perjury, that the foregoing representations are true.


DETENTION CONSIDERATIONS

MOTION FOR DETENTION

Comes now the State of Indiana by Prosecuting Attorney, Kenneth P. Cotter, in and for the 60th Judicial Circuit, St. Joseph County, and by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, Jennifer J McKinney and pursuant to **I.C. 35-33-8-6**, respectfully requests this Court **DETAIN** the above mentioned Defendant for a maximum period of fifteen (15) days. In support of said motion, the State recites the following:

1. That on July 2, 2020, the Defendant was convicted of Auto Theft (Aiding), as a Class A Misdemeanor in Cause No. 71D08-1908-F6-000812;
2. That the Defendant is currently on parole or probation for that offense;
3. That the State alleges, in the above captioned case, that on or about June 7, 2021 the Defendant committed the crimes of Count 1: Armed Robbery, a Level 3 Felony ; Count 2: Aiding, Inducing, or Causing Armed Robbery, a Level 3 Felony and has contemporaneously filed this/these charge(s) herein;
4. That the State respectfully request this Court **DETAIN** the Defendant for a maximum period of fifteen (15) days, as provided by I.C. 35-33-8-6, within which the parole or probation authority may take the appropriate action against the Defendant;
5. That if the parole or probation authority fails to initiate parole or probation revocation proceedings within the next fifteen (15) days, the State recognizes that the Court will rescind this **DETAINER**, and place the Defendant on bond previously set in this cause.

WHEREFORE, the State respectfully requests this Court **ORDER** the Defendant be **DETAINED** and held on **NO BOND** until fifteen (15) days from said **ORDER**, and all other relief just and proper.

and after review, **FINDS** that said Motion should be **GRANTED**.

Specifically, the Court **FINDS** that the State has filed a criminal charge(s) against the Defendant in the above captioned cause. The Court **FURTHER FINDS** that the Defendant was on parole or probation at the time that this new offense occurred.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to I.C. 35-33-8-6, this Court hereby **ORDERS** that the Defendant be **DETAINED** and **HELD** on **NO BOND** until the probation or parole authority initiates probation or parole revocation or for a maximum of fifteen (15) days.

IN ADDITION, **if** said authority **fails** to initiate said proceedings within the next fifteen (15) days, this Court **HEREBY RESCINDS** this ORDER, and re-instates the bond originally found in this cause.
