South Bend Alive Grant- "Organization Description" 299 words

The Dream Builders Project, Inc., was first created in the Fall of 2012, as a solution to address and arrest the continual development of negative cognitive mindsets over anger, frustration and hopelessness, that was so prevalent within the prison population. It was the common patterns found within the collective thoughts and shared experiences of these men that participated in the project that has made it evolve into the youth program it is today, formally established October 29th/2020.

We realized that the common denominator of these men was equated to life experiences of learned behaviors formed through unhealthy thinking processes from their youth stage of life. A couple of examples would be, 1) never learning to process emotions in a healthy way that was experienced in adverse or confusing times, and 2) a lack of life experiences that cultivates a diverse and broad ranging world view. These concepts were the impetus for our mission statement which reads as follows, "The Dream Builders Project, Inc. mission is to emancipate the arrested development found within the cognitive processes of adolescent youths surrounding their ability to reason within their decision-making stages to create a healthy and proactive life worth living".

The Dream Builders Project, Inc., governs its curriculum around two basic concepts. First, through the correct assessment tools, allowing the participant to define which career path they would choose for their life, and objectively placing them on that path. Secondly, equipping the participants with certain educational paradigms. We believe in that if you cannot see yourself as acceptable in the society in which you live in, that person cannot expect to succeed in it. Therefore, extending our reach to build community relationships, (city residents & local businesses etc.), is not only important but necessary for the advancement of not only youth, but our city.

This program will begin with classroom Life Skills training, class will be held weekly on Saturday and will remain in session for one hour and 45mins. Classes are scheduled to continue through October 30, 2021. The Dream Builders Project, INC will implement each step of this project by introducing and rolling out each training system in increments with a before assessment questionnaire of the module being introduced and a after assessment questionnaire introduced after module has been covered and, reviewed. Each student will answer the questionnaire at the beginning of each training module and at the completion of each training module, this will serve as confirmed measure of what was learned. Each area of the training modules will be covered and rolled out over the scheduled calendar of training sessions as described in the written scope.~~

The Dream Builder's Project, Inc., is located at 1612 Lincoln Way West, with a Projected start date of Monday, February 01/2020. With the rate and pace in which our youth are turning to adverse lifestyles, we feel that to reach them at an impressionable age we have selected the targeted age group of 8-13yrs old. This decision was based on our projects vision and overall goal. 1) Vision- is that socioeconomic challenged city youths become intellectually compatible to their more advanced counterparts and therefore cultivate a meaningful and crime-free future for themselves and their families. 2) Goal- is to create a career development environment where the obtainment of healthy self-images, life skills, and cognitive processes can be gained.

These two elements are long ranging in scope but also objective in nature. Included within the framework of our assessment tools and curriculum are two types of mentors, Program & Curriculum. These mentors would ensure accountability, fairness and choice. In addition to these mentors, it is our hope to have parents/guardians alike participate in the projects planned activities which may range from some class time and family activities, to community outings, to addressing participants assessments/career goals. There has been steady effort to create an innate sense of culture at the interior of the center of The Dream Builders Project. As a direct result of those efforts, upon day one the South Bend Civic Theater will assist our project by providing workshops, creative writing classes and role plays for our project. Ivy Tech ensures their presence with providing a holistic curriculum suitable for our age group. This would provide credibility to what is being shared and taught, as well how it is being relayed to the participants.

Therefore, a typical day at Dream Builders Project and during a school year, would be on a Saturday afternoon for two and a half hours, where snack and lunch would be provided for them. Both curriculum and creative workshops will be held. There would be set timing for mentor/mentee engagement. It is here where participants will plan out their career goals etc.. and it is here were participants begin to learn and gain a collective mind and awareness due to becoming each other's support system. This is not to say every program day is repetitive, however this is a basic format.

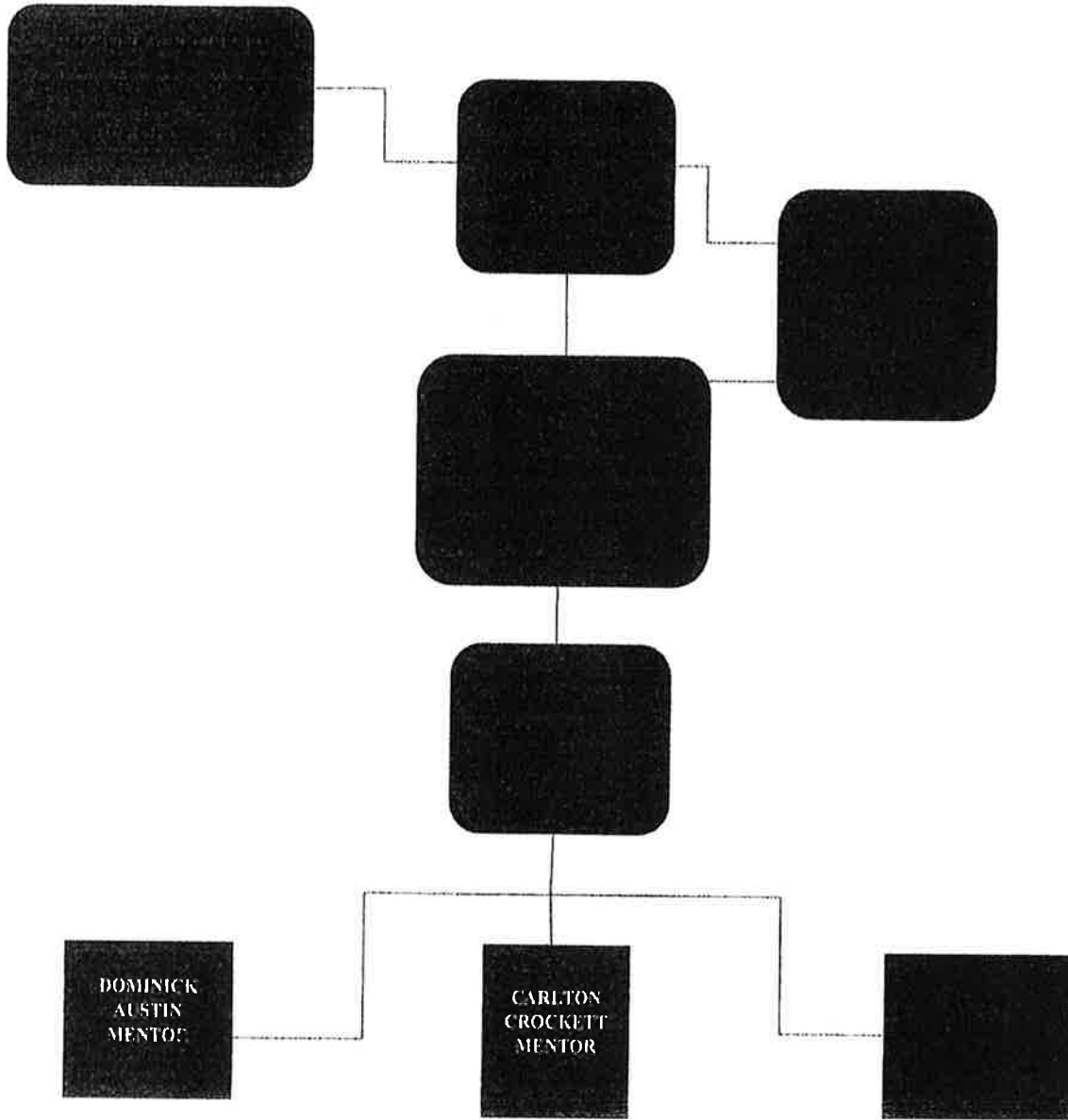
