
COUNT I

On or about January 27, 2019 in St. Joseph County, State of Indiana, Montell O'neal did knowingly touch [REDACTED], a family or household member, in a rude insolent or angry manner, resulting in serious bodily injury, a broken collar bone and broken tooth.

All of which is contrary to the form of the statutes in such cases made and provided by I.C. 35-42-2-1.3(a)(1) and I.C. 35-42-2-1.3(c)(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.

I affirm under the penalties for perjury that the foregoing representations are true.

Kayla M. McBride, upon information and belief and affirming under the penalties for perjury, states that:
 I am the Deputy Prosecuting Attorney with the 60th Judicial Circuit, St. Joseph County, State of Indiana.
 I have reviewed verified Mishawaka Police Department reports and medical records of [REDACTED] as well as the criminal history for MONTELL O'NEAL. I make this affidavit based upon those reports.

On January 27, 2019, Mishawaka Police were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference a fight between [REDACTED] and her child's father, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] explained that she believed O'NEAL was upset with her because she wasn't able to transport their child to him for the custody swap. O'NEAL arrived at her apartment to pick up their mutual child. O'NEAL then began pushing and shoving her and told [REDACTED] that he wasn't going to bring their son back. O'NEAL picked up [REDACTED] and threw her to the ground on multiple occasions. Officers observed a chipped tooth and Lane complained of injury to her shoulder and was transported to St. Joseph Regional Medical center. Once at the hospital it was determined that [REDACTED] had broken her collarbone and broke a tooth, among other abrasions and injuries.

All of the above occurred in St. Joseph County, Indiana.

DETENTION CONSIDERATIONS

II. The Defendant is a a substantial flight risk or a danger to self, others or the community for the following reasons:

1. The victim responded positively to six out of eleven possible question on the DA-LE questionnaire. More positive answers indicate that the victim is at greater risk of injury or death. The victim indicates that she believes the defendant may try and kill her.
2. The victim suffered significant injuries as a result of this event.

WHEREFORE, the State requests that the Court detain the Defendant until the Court conducts a bail hearing in open court.

I affirm, under the pains and penalties for perjury, that the foregoing representations are true.
