AFFIDAVIT IN  
SUPPORT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Adam Taylor affirms under the penalty of perjury and states:

I am a Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for the 60th Judicial Circuit, and make this affidavit after viewing verified South Bend Police Department (SBPD) reports.

On or about June 20, 2020, Officer Williams of the SBPD received a report at the police station from [REDACTED], who stated that he was assaulted at his business location at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that his granddaughter's father, MONTELL ROBERT O'NEAL, came to the restaurant claiming that he wanted to see his daughter. [REDACTED] stated that O'NEAL was making a scene, and was yelling and screaming. As [REDACTED] was trying to speak with him, O'NEAL grabbed [REDACTED], and slammed him to the ground, and then punched him approximately ten times in the face and body. O'NEAL then fled the restaurant.

All of the above events occurred in St. Joseph County, Indiana.
