Ryan Wexler affirms under the penalty of perjury and states:

I am a Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for the 60th Judicial Circuit, and make this affidavit after viewing verified St. Joseph County Sheriff's Department reports.

According to the reports, on or about August 6, 2023, St Joseph County Police officers were travelling westbound on SR 2 near Hollywood Rd in South Bend when they observed a Jeep Renegade near a ditch. Officers approached and had the driver, later identified as RYAN PREBYS, exit the vehicle as it was at a steep angle and could possibly roll over. While doing so, officers observed PREBYS had slurred speech and bloodshot eyes. Officers asked PREBYS if he had anything to drink, to which PREBYS replied he had a few drinks. Officers moved PEBYS to a nearby location to administer Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. PREBYS failed all three tests administered. After officers read him Indiana Implied Consent Warnings, PREBYS agreed to take a certified chemical test. Officers transported RPEBYS to the St Joseph County Jail, where he performed a Chemical Breath Test. The results of that test showed 0.188 grams of alcohol per 210 liters of PREBYS's breath.

All of the above events occurred in St. Joseph County, Indiana.

**DETENTION CONSIDERATIONS**

I. The State has no further information concerning the Defendant's substantial risk of flight or danger to self or others.
